



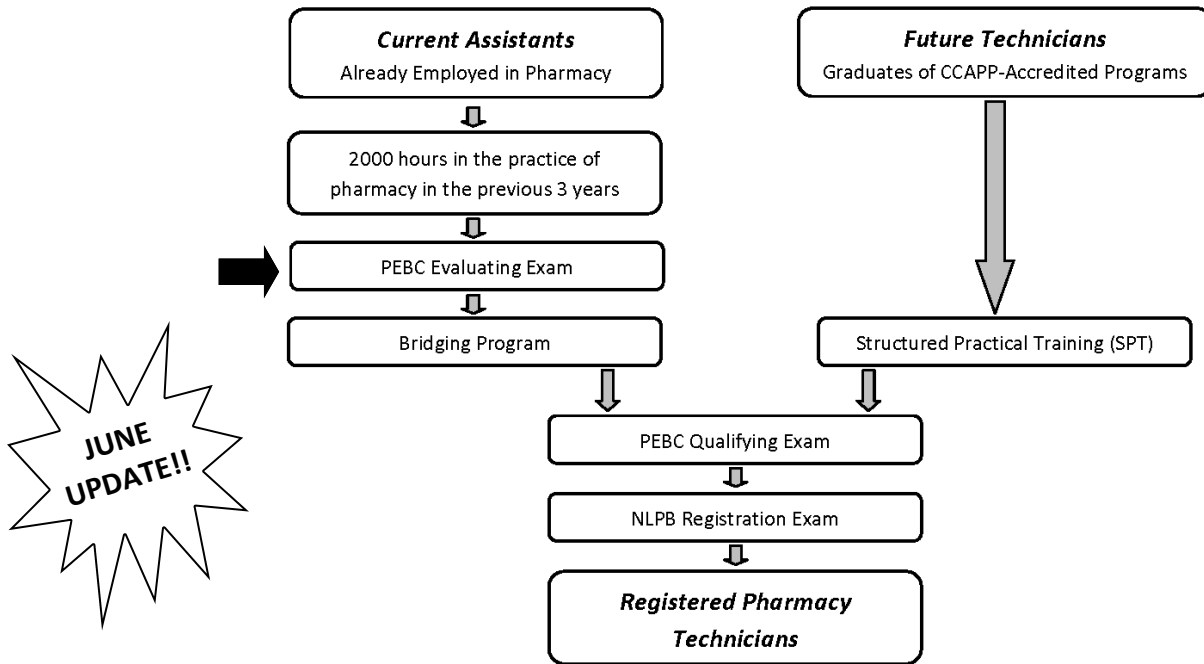

Additional Information for Pharmacy Assistants Intending to Proceed Through the Pharmacy Technician Regulation Process in Newfoundland and Labrador

Pharmacy Examining Board of Canada (PEBC) Pharmacy Technician Evaluating Exam

As stated in our previous communication of April 22, 2010, the Newfoundland and Labrador Pharmacy Board is moving forward with Pharmacy Technician Regulation in this province. As you know, part of the process for “Current Assistants” wishing to be regulated is writing the PEBC Evaluating Exam (see diagram below). We have confirmed with PEBC that they intend to offer this exam in three locations in Newfoundland and Labrador on **September 18, 2010 – St. John’s, Grand Falls and Corner Brook**. All sites are subject to cancellation if sufficient registration numbers are not achieved. We would like to remind potential applicants once again that applications **MUST** be received by PEBC no later than **June 28, 2010**. Once your application is approved, PEBC will contact you approximately three weeks prior to the exam, confirming exam day rules, exact sitting location, time, etc.
