Awards and Honours

Overview

Emerald Achievement Award

The purpose of this award is to recognize NLPB registrants who have practiced pharmacy for at least 35 years.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for an Emerald Achievement Award, the registrant must:

- Be currently registered and in good standing with NLPB;
- Have been registered with NLPB for a minimum of 35 years from the date of initial registration; and
- Have never been found guilty of professional misconduct.

NLPB Certificate of Recognition

The purpose of this certificate of recognition is to recognize registrants for their outstanding dedication and contribution to the Newfoundland and Labrador Pharmacy Board. The number of Certificates of Recognition granted in one year is not limited and certificates do not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for a Certificate of Recognition, the registrant must:

- Be currently registered and in good standing with NLPB; and
- Have made a special contribution to the NLPB on a local, provincial or national level.

In addition, the nominator must be able to provide evidence of the registrant's:

- Commitment to the profession of pharmacy; and
- Contribution to the work of the NLPB in fulfilling its mandate of public protection.

Patient Safety Award

The purpose of this award is to recognize the achievement of an individual registrant, a group of registrants, an interdisciplinary group (that includes registrant(s) as key participants), or a pharmacy organization that has made a significant and lasting contribution to improving patient safety through a specific project or initiative. This award does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for a Patient Safety Award, the registrant must:

- Be currently registered and in good standing with NLPB.

In addition, the nominator must be able to provide evidence of the registrant's:

- Innovation in the delivery of patient centered care;
- Commitment to continuous quality improvement; and
- Positive impact upon patient safety.
